Personal Note from Fr Sean

The past two weeks have been a heavy challenge to me as I have had to grapple with the sadness of losing my mother, Kathleen, suddenly and unexpectedly, on 4 January. This has been the most challenging and heart-breaking time in my life. I would sincerely like to thank all those who have supported me in so many ways in the midst of this difficulty. Mam was buried on the Feast of the Epiphany, the feast of those who search for Wisdom despite the cold and difficult struggle of life. That Wisdom might best be seen in the brave flames of hope that people have offered in their kindness, particularly from the parish here. For all those flames of hope offered in the winter darkness, I am heartfully thankful.

I know that some people had wanted to travel to Graiguenamanagh for the Wake and Funeral Mass but were unable to do so because of the inclement weather. I hope to offer Mass for my mother at 7.30pm on Friday 31 January in Broadford. My brother, cousin and uncle also hope to attend (My Dad is a bit too frail to travel). It will offer an opportunity to anyone who may have wished to attend the funeral, but was unable to do so for those good reasons of inclement weather, to be present at an occasion of prayer and solidarity. However, I again reiterate that your quiet prayers and gentle support have already made a huge difference in this moment of grief.

I ask your patience over the next while. We are a small family and I need to attend to some family needs that are urgent and immediate. However I hope to fulfil all parish duties also, but maybe asking a little leniency and understanding.

My mother was a kind, shy and practical person and her loss is enormous. For those of you who share the burden of loss in these days, the heartbeat of hope and strength is in the prayerful remembrance of all our loved ones, particularly at Mass. There is a strange and beautiful strength in our prayerful remembering and hoping around the Lord's table. Many thanks!
